

June 9, 2020 Minutes

The Coffee County Legislative Body met June 9, 2020 in a regular scheduled meeting by conference call at 6:00 PM.

EMA Director Allen Lendley proclaimed the meeting open for business.

Pastor Tony Buchanan from Christian Life Church gave the Invocation and Allen Lendley led the Pledge to the Flag.

All 21 members were present for the meeting.

Mayor Cordell requested a motion to amend the agenda by removing Resolution 2020-15. Motion made by Hunt and seconded by Debellis to approve the agenda. Amendment by Kraft and seconded by Ray to itemize budget items individually and vote on them one by one. Upon roll call the amendment passed with 19 yes votes and Cunningham voting no. Poston did not vote. Upon roll call the motion was approved as amended with 15 yes votes and 6 no votes. Yes votes were Debellis, Hollandsworth, Crockett, Hobbs, Hunt, Keele, Orrick, Taylor, Fielding, Kraft, Ray, Deford, Tim Stubblefield, Tildon Stubblefield and Duncan, and voting no were Bryan, Cunningham, Miller, Poston, Crabtree and Sebourn.

Motion made by Debellis and seconded by Taylor to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion was approved by roll call with 21 yes votes.

Motion made by Crabtree and seconded by Crockett to approve the notaries as listed: Roger J. Bean, Elizabeth T. Ezell, Richard W. Gabreil, Dwight E. Norton, Kathy Nunley, William C. Rieder, Heather D. Shelton, Jamie S. Trimble, Jennifer S. Vickers and Diana Keele Williams. Upon roll call the motion was approved with 21 yes votes.

Motion made by Bryan and seconded by Kraft for the adoption of Resolution 2020-14 to approve road construction project and authorize the Mayor to sign proposal contract with the Department of Transportation. Upon roll call the motion was approved with 21 yes votes.

Motion made by Cunningham and seconded by Tim Stubblefield for the approval of Summit Jail Food Service Contract and authority for the Purchasing Agent to execute. Upon roll call the motion was approved with 21 yes votes.

Motion made by Bryan and seconded by Orrick to authorize and direct County Mayor to re-negotiate 911 Inter-local Agreement with the primary objective that all employees of 911 will be funded by 911 including salaries and benefits. New agreement effective date to be 1-1-21. Transfer of employee payroll and benefits for 911 from county to 911 to be effective 1-1-21. Budgeted amount for 911 for Fiscal Year 2021 will reflect funding for 911 payroll and benefits only until 1-1-21. Upon roll call the motion was approved with 21 yes votes.

Motion made by Bryan and seconded by Crabtree to approve budget amendment #152-2020-14 Rural Debt Service. Upon roll call the motion was approved with 21 yes votes.

Motion made by Debellis and seconded by Duncan to approve budget amendment #118-2020-15 Ambulance Service. Upon roll call the motion was approved with 21 yes votes.

Motion made by Orrick and seconded by Kraft to approve budget amendment #171-2020-16 Rural Capital Projects. Upon roll call the motion was approved with 21 yes votes.

Motion made by Crabtree and seconded by Cunningham to approve budget amendment #101-2020-17 General Fund. Upon roll call the motion was approved with 15 yes votes and 6 no votes. Yes votes were Debellis, Hollandsworth, Crockett, Bryan, Hunt, Cunningham, Keele, Orrick, Taylor, Fielding, Miller, Poston, Duncan, Crabtree and Sebourn and voting no were Hobbs, Kraft, Ray, Deford, Tim Stubblefield and Tildon Stubblefield.

Motion made by Orrick and seconded by Debellis to approve the report on Debt Obligation. Upon roll call the motion was approved with 21 yes votes.

Motion made by Debellis and seconded by Ray to approve grant pre-application notification form to Manchester and Tullahoma Libraries. Upon roll call the motion was approved with 21 yes votes.

There being no further business the County Legislative Body adjourned.
