After our meeting last night with the West Warren Utility District, I believe we have made great strides in helping three of our volunteer fire departments. We also learned that we need to help them. That is by reporting any water usage at the end of each month. Contacting them when you are testing or flushing hydrants. (REMEMBER you WILL NOT BE BILLED FOR THIS WATER.) By keeping up with your usage it helps them determine if they have leaks in their system, which is again important to all of us. We want as much volume and pressure they can supply.

Also, we learned that most hydrants located on their lines are not capable of having a pumper attached to them. They are capable of filling your portable storage units. It is also important to NEVER PUT A HYDRANT OUT OF SERVICE, my understanding last night is they are the only ones allowed to do this. If you feel that a hydrant is in need of service or that there is a leak in the line, I am attaching contact information below.
