The Coffee County Legislative Body met April 11, 2023 in a regular scheduled meeting at the Coffee County Administrative Plaza at 6:00 PM.

Sheriff Chad Partin proclaimed the meeting open for business.

Roy Slaughter of First Baptist Church of Hillsboro gave the Invocation and Commissioner Dwight Miller led the Pledge to the Flag.

There were 17 members present for the meeting with Nettles being absent.

Motion made by Hunt and seconded by Hollandsworth to amend the agenda by adding notaries under 11e. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes. Motion made by Hershman and seconded by Hollandsworth to approve the agenda as amended. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes.

Motion made by Sebourn and seconded by Hollandsworth to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes.

Motion made by Hershman and seconded by Duncan for the adoption of Resolution 2023-M-06 a proclamation to Commemorate March 31st as “Mrs. Roberta Jane Proffitt Day” who is 106 years and the oldest resident of Coffee County.

County Mayor Judd Matheny honored Sheriff Chad Partin for his courage and bravery in defusing a situation that had the potential to develop into an altercation with casualties and presented him with the County Flag.

Dennis Hunt gave a presentation on the Health Department construction status.

Motion made by Hershman and seconded by Sebourn to approve three Coffee County Government Grant Pre-Application Notification forms for the Coffee County Manchester Public Library. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes.

Motion made by Duncan and seconded by Stubblefield to approve two Coffee County Government Grant Pre-Application Notification forms for the Coffee County Sheriff's Department. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes.

Motion made by Deford and second by Stubblefield for the adoption of Resolution 2023-M-04 authorizing Coffee County to join the State of Tennessee and other local governments in amending the Tennessee State-Subdivision opioid abatement agreement and approving the related settlement agreements. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes.

Motion made by Morris and seconded by Hershman for the adoption of Resolution 2023-M-05 authorizing submission for a litter and trash collection grant from the Tennessee Department of Transportation and Authorizing the acceptance of said grant. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes.
