Motion made by Hunt and seconded by Hollandsworth to approve Brian Reed replacing Rennie Bell who resigned to the Central Tennessee Solid Waste Planning Region Board. The motion was approved with 19 yes votes.

Motion made by Orrick and seconded by Cunningham to approve the Election Systems & Software, LLC Hardware Maintenance and Software License, Maintenance and Support Services Agreement. The motion was approved with 19 yes votes.
